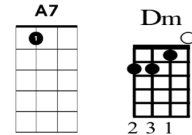


WALK RIGHT BACK

I'm so lonesome every-day

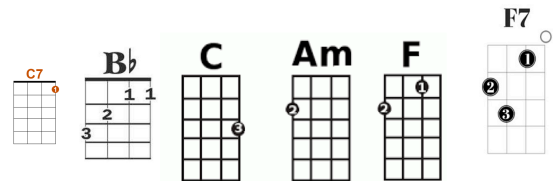
Repeat all, and then:

I'm so lonesome every-day

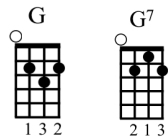


Ukes 'n' more
